



Punxsutawney Community Center 2019 Annual Craft Show-n-Sale

Punxsutawney Area Community Center
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Thank you to everyone who made Groundhog Day 2018 a success. Planning for the 2019 celebration has already begun!
The Annual Craft Show-n-Sale will once again be held inside the gym at the
Punxsutawney Area Community Center in downtown Punxsutawney.
As in prior years, we hope that this will be a fun-filled event for both the tourists and townies!

This year's show will start on Friday, February 1, from 1pm – 9pm and continue on Saturday, February 2,
GROUNDHOG DAY, from 7am – 2pm. Our space is limited, so it is necessary to be registered & paid
on a first come - first pay - first serve basis. There is a limit of 2 spaces per vendor.

Set up will be from 8am – noon. Doors to the public will open at 1pm on Feb. 1st. The first 26 PAID tables will be located
INSIDE the gym. The doors of the gym will be locked at night, so you need not tear down before leaving. The doors will
be unlocked at 6am on Feb. 2nd. Please be ready to stay for both days. Parking is in the borough lot across the street.
Limited unloading time at the door is also available. Please bring a dolly to help move your stuff!

Two-day fee is \$55.00. Please add \$5 for electricity, if needed. We are very limited on outlets – *only 6 electric spots!*

The deadline for application and fees is due Friday, January 26th, 2019. Enclosed is the vendor application.
Please be sure to include your sales tax number and liability insurance if you have it. Checks should be made payable to
the Punxsutawney Area Community Center. Please provide a brief description of your products. Remember that the
majority of our shoppers will be tourists looking for groundhog souvenirs and mementos of their trip to the “Groundhog
Capital of the World”, but other items are permitted. However, any objectionable items will be removed.

The cost of a space (10 feet long by 5 feet deep) for February 1st and 2nd will be \$55.00. Each space allows for an
8' table and 2' for walkways. Electricity, at an additional \$5 charge, (only 6 available!), is on a first requested basis, but
you provide your own cords. Again, checks should be made payable to the Punxsutawney Area Community Center.
Each vendor is responsible for own display, tables, chairs and garbage, power cords & dolly. Tables should be covered to
the floor with extra inventory and storage boxes under tables.
